In the span of a week, children will experience many peaceful practices, including building a global community, meditating, walking labyrinths, singing, dancing, and more. In these ways, PeaceKids will continue their journey on the path to peaceful living.

Peace Camp 2008 will be held in two sessions, each from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 pm, for children who have completed Kindergarten through Fifth grade. **SESSION ONE—for children who have completed Kindergarten through Second grade**—runs from July 28th – August 1st. **SESSION TWO—for children who have completed Third grade through Fifth grade**—runs from August 4th – August 8th. Each session will culminate in a celebration family potluck on Friday from 12 noon-1:30 pm.

Registration opens April 1st for First UU members. Spaces remaining after April 30th will be open to the public.

Registrants will receive a confirmation letter soon after they register with an emergency form, volunteer opportunities, and more details.
